Executive Summary

Love Beyond Limits is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to empowering children and young adults with diverse abilities. Our mission is to create inclusive communities that support development, independence, and purpose. This proposal outlines our plan to develop a new school campus designed to serve individuals with developmental disabilities through therapeutic education, sensory integration, and vocational training.

Our vision is to purchase and build out 12 cottages, each converted into modern therapy offices and classrooms, create a state-of-the-art sensory room, and establish a fully functional agriculture food garden. This facility will serve as a model environment that blends education, therapy, and real-life vocational experience.

Components of the Project:

1. 10 Cottages for Therapy & Classrooms

- **Cost per cottage (includes bathroom buildout and accessibility upgrades):** \$25,000
- **Total:** \$250,000
- **Purpose:** Each cottage will house specialized classrooms or therapy offices tailored to various developmental and therapeutic needs.

2. State-of-the-Art Sensory Room

- **Budget:** \$60,000
- **Purpose:** This room will be equipped with the latest sensory equipment to provide calming, stimulating, and therapeutic experiences to students with sensory processing needs.

3. Life Skill Training Apartment

- **Budget:** \$20,000
- **Purpose:** This space will be designed to replicate a real-life apartment, complete with a kitchen, bathroom, bedroom, and laundry room. It will serve as a hands-on learning environment where students can develop and practice essential daily living skills such as cooking, cleaning, and personal hygiene. Our goal is to build confidence, independence, and readiness for life beyond the classroom

4. Agriculture Food Garden & Vocational Program

- **Budget:** \$60,000
- **Purpose:** This hands-on garden will teach life skills, offer work opportunities, and provide nutritional education. Children and young adults will plant, grow, and harvest food, gaining valuable work experience and a sense of accomplishment.

5. 15 Passenger Van

- **Budget:** \$20,000
- **Purpose:** This vehicle will be used to safely transport children and young adults to and from community-based activities, educational field trips, job training sites, therapeutic sessions, and recreational outings

Outcomes & Impact

- Serve 100+ students with individualized education and therapy plans.
- Provide on-site therapies, eliminating the need for families to travel elsewhere.
- Promote vocational independence and life skills through real-world garden work.
- Enhance sensory regulation and emotional wellness with a cutting-edge sensory space.
- Offer an inclusive, purpose-driven environment that models community integration.

Sustainability Plan

- The garden will generate produce to be sold locally or used on campus, with proceeds reinvested.
- Ongoing operational support will come from donations, grants, and partnerships.
- Parent engagement and volunteer programs will reduce staffing costs and build community involvement.
